Dear 7th - 12th Grade Parents and Students:

This is an information sheet concerning camp which will be held at the Spruce Lake Retreat Center in Canadensis, PA. This year's dates are Monday, September 24th - Friday, September 25th. We will leave at approximately 8:30 a.m. on Monday, September 24th and return at approximately 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 25th.

As a reminder, school camp is **required** for every student in grades 7-12. School camp is a great way to get to know all students in a more informal and fun setting. One of the main goals of PCS is a Christ-centered education, and school camp starts the school year out with a spiritual emphasis.

Attached to this letter, you will find a permission slip for the retreat. Below are some guidelines to follow. Keep in mind that this is a school event, and all things pertaining to it will follow school guidelines.

## **Dress Code:**

- Causal dress is appropriate. MODESTY is the key.
- Shorts may be worn, but they must come to the knee. Please do not wear your PCS gym shorts for this event unless they do come to the knee. The gym shorts do tend to be above the knee and work well for gym but not for situations where the students will be doing a lot of sitting. (As a side note, this is true for Color Days as well.)
- You may wear loose fitting jeans.
- Tank tops of any kind should not be worn.
- For ladies, shirt and t-shirt collars should be no lower than one inch from the collar bone.
- School rules regarding jewelry for guys still apply.
- Bring a bathing suit. Please keep in mind our policy on modesty. No bikinis or otherwise revealing swimsuits. Miss Hockman will review this policy with the ladies before the trip.
- For each service, casual dress is allowed, please remember to look neat.
- Anyone not adhering to the dress code will be asked to return to their cabin and change their clothing.

**What to bring:**

- Bedding and pillow
- Warm clothing
- Toiletries and towel
- Flashlight
- More than one pair of sneakers or shoes
- Money for the snack shop
- Bible
- An enthusiastic spirit

**What NOT to bring:**

- Anything prohibited at school (iPods, laptops, video games, CD players, radios, etc.)
- Students may not bring their phones. The purpose of camp is to get away from society and the regular routine and to let God speak to our students' hearts. Second, our goal is to promote social interaction with fellow students. Cell phones hamper this process. Phone numbers of the camp and chaperones will be provided ahead of the trip in case of emergency.
