- **Heritage and History:** Parsippany Christian School began as a ministry of Parsippany Baptist Church in 1970. For 45 years, Parsippany Christian School has offered a solid, quality Christian education. Students have consistently scored above the state and national average on standardized tests as well as on the ACT and SAT. Our alumni have attended a wide variety of colleges and gone on to succeed in a wide variety of vocations including full-time ministry.
- **Mission:** Our mission is to assist parents in the academic, physical, social, and spiritual education of their children through sound academics integrated with Biblical principles. It is also our mission to train the next generation to demonstrate Biblical wisdom while being vocationally successful and, more importantly, while investing their lives for eternal treasures.
- **Philosophy:** It is our desire to be distinct and separate from the world. Desiring to maintain this distinction and separation, we discourage bringing the world's philosophy into our school life in areas such as dress and hairstyles as well as in worldly entertainment such as music, movies, television, etc. At P.C.S., we strive for high academic standards and a quality education. We believe truth and wisdom, upon which education is based, ultimately emanates from God and His Word. At P.C.S., this means the Word of God will be revered and taught in every class as well as in determining rules and discipline procedures. It is integrated into the very fabric of our daily routines and into student life thus building a Biblical worldview for our students. In an effort to enhance this endeavor, we have chosen primarily Bob Jones University Press and A Beka Books for our curriculum.
- **Memberships:** Member of the American Association of Christian Schools and Garden State Association of Christian Schools
- **Programs:** PCS consists of PreKindergarten through 12th Grade.
 - **PK/K:** Both full day classes, PK and Kindergarten are combined, but a teacher's aide enables time to be split and dedicated to both classes. Pre-K students must be 4 years old by October 1, and Kindergarteners must be 5 by October 1.
 - **1-5 grades:** Elementary classes consist of the core courses along with Handwriting, Spelling, Music, Art, and some Computer classes.
 - **6-8 Grades:** Middle School classes consist of the core courses, Physical Education, Keyboarding (7-8 grades). As well, each student must take at least one Fine Art such as Art, Chess, Choir, Band, or Forensics.
 - **8-12 Grades:** Senior High classes consist of the core courses, Physical Education/Health, two years of Spanish, Computers, Microbiology, and a SAT Prep/Research/Career Ed class. Electives include Advanced Physics, Advanced Chemistry, Advanced Math, and Psychology. Each student must take at least one Fine Art such as Art, Chess, Choir, Band, Forensics, or Home Economics.
 - **Athletics:** We offer co-ed Middle School Soccer and Volleyball as well as Girl's and Boy's MS Basketball. For Varsity, we have Girl's and Boy's Soccer, Basketball, and Volleyball. PCS is a member of the Metro Christian Athletic Association.

- **Hours:** Official school hours are 8:20 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. However, we have morning care beginning at 7:00 a.m. and Aftercare until 5:30 p.m.
- **Facilities:** Library, Fully-functional Science Lab, 18 Apple Computers (12 laptops), 6 Windows laptops, Gymnasium, Playground Equipment, and access to Parsippany turf fields for soccer
- **Website:** At pcspatriots.org, you will find daily and weekly information to keep you up-to-date on all you need to know.
- **FACTS Management:** FACTS facilitates our billing and payments. This offers parents the luxury of paying by cash, check, bank debit, or credit card.
- **Headmaster:** Our grading program allows you daily access to your child's grades and progress. It is available to you via the Headmaster icon on our website.
- **Honeywell Instant Alert:** This automated system will keep you abreast of important information including school closings and delays.
- **Dress Code:** Uniform for classes and P.E.
- **Lunch Program:** Pizza is offered three days a week for \$1.50/slice. The Junior and Senior classes offer a hot lunch for \$3 the other two days. Water or a Capri Sun are available as well.
